*City International School Wanowrie has planned 4 nights and 5 days Educational Trip to 'Aurangabad' one of the most important Historical City in Maharashtra. It is also known as one of the fastest growing city in Asia.*

*Being a part of our CBSE Project related to Heritage Culture we have selected this city to visit as it will furnish information about our Indian Culture.*

***Following is the planned itinerary with the Educational Relevance***

- 1. Chaitnya Agro Farm-*** Fun filled with farm activities, Farm tour, Village games to get the hands experience of the village
- 2. Ajanta Caves-*** Magnificent caves containing carving that depict life of Buddha. There are about 30 rock-cut Buddhist cave monuments amidst lavish green mountains. Which date from the 2<sup>nd</sup> century BCE to about 480 or 650 CE. The caves include paintings and sculptures which are masterpieces of Buddhist Religious art.
- 3. Lunar Lake-*** Lunar lake is a saline soda lake located at Lonar in Buldana district Maharashtra, which was created by a meteor impact during Pleistocene Epoch. It is both saline and alkaline in nature.
- 4. Daitya Sudan Temple*** – It is a Vishnu Temple dated to Chalukya Dynasty which ruled central & southern part of India between 6<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> centuries. The exterior walls are covered with carved figures.
- 5. Daulatabad Fort*** – Devagiri (Daulatabad) of later period 11 kms from 'Aurangabad' is famous for its formidable hill fort. It is an interesting trek for the students having a rich cultural heritage importance.
- 6. Ellora Caves-*** are an impressive complex of Buddhist, Hindu and Jain cave temples built in between the 6<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> centuries AD near the ancient Indian village Ellora. Ellora is a world Heritage site.
- 7. Mughal Silk Bazaar*** – Exhibits the famous Himroo Shawals, Bed-sheets and also the Paithani Sarees. give more brief please as per the itinerary given.

The cost of the trip is INR 9499/- per person (Nine Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Nine Only) for classes IV till X. The trip is scheduled from Thursday, 25<sup>th</sup> December 2014 to Monday, 29<sup>th</sup> December 2014. The above amount can be paid via cheque/cash before Wednesday, 10<sup>th</sup> December 2014.
