Emergency Medical Care

Dear Parents,

In our School we try to take utmost care and look into the safety of our students and all related stakeholders. But some time the situation regarding the accident / injury / illness of any stake holder may get out of hand and at that time First Aid may not help and the student (patient) may require immediate doctor's treatment / hospitalization.

Accidental Injuries &/or illness: If it is deemed that a student is ill or injured while at school, we will attempt to contact the parent/guardian or the person listed as the emergency contact to send the child home. In the interim, the child will be made as comfortable as possible in the school. If the illness or injury appears to be serious, medical advice will be sought and followed. For injuries or accidents, first aid will be administered as needed, and an attempt will be made to notify the parent(s). When a parent or guardian cannot be reached, and the injury is serious, a staff member will accompany the student to the nearest Clinic / Hospital. Effort will be made to contact the parent first. A member of the school staff will accompany the student and stay with the child until a parent has been contacted. For minor injuries, such as bumps and scratches, first aid is administered at school. It is important that we always have your current phone number(s) and that all parents provide an alternative phone number or contact person. While on a School trip / excursion in case of a medical emergency the students' parents are informed and medical help is provided immediately with the parents' permission.
